



Guidelines for Abstract Preparation

It is *essential* that the following guidelines are used to avoid excessive reformatting of abstracts. Submitted abstracts which do not follow the guidelines below will be returned to the author for retyping if extensive reformatting is required, please note that this may delay acceptance of your abstract.

General guidelines:

- Your manuscript will be reproduced in color exactly as received. Therefore, the manuscript must be clear and beautiful.
- These instructions show the formats of abstract. Authors are requested to refer to this sample.

Guidelines for technical preparation of abstract:

- Title:
The title must be bolded and centered. The font size is 14 Pt.
- Text:
The length of the abstract should be 2 pages of A4 size including table and figures.
Text should be 12 point type size, Times New Roman, single spacing (1 line spacing for MS-word)
Margins should be 25mm at the top and bottom of the text, also 25 mm on either side.
- Tables and Figures:
Tables and figures that assist in substantiating the text, as well as data summaries, are encouraged. They can be reproduced in color format.
- Biography
Include your brief biography at the last part.

Abstract must be submitted through the following URL:

Introduction: The required styles for the abstract are illustrated in this Microsoft WORD document. A typical but not limited structure is: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, and Acknowledgement.

Materials and Methods: Abstracts should be formatted for A4 paper (210 x 297 mm). The top margin should be set to 25 mm, bottom margin to 25 mm, and left and right margins to 25 mm. The entire document should be set to a single column.

Results and Discussion: Title should be in upper and lower case, 14 pt Times, centered. Authors should be listed consecutively by full name. The presenting author's name must be underlined. The corresponding author's e-mail address should be indicated. Affiliation should be indicated with superscripted suffix Arabic numerals. Do not append degrees, professional designations, etc., to names. The body of the document should be set in 12 pt Times, justified, with single line-spacing. Use of photographs and graphics is encouraged. Sample reference entries [1-3] are given in the References section. References should be set as one block, as below, and a maximum of six (< 6) references should be adhered to.

Conclusions: The length of the abstract should be 2 pages. The abstracts must be submitted via e-mail as attachments.
